DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The purpose of this project is to remove invasive, non-native plants within 47 acres of the Delta Meadows Unit to prevent the spread of these plants downstream and restore habitat for native flora and fauna. California State Parks staff and youth conservation corps will use hand tools to pull and cut invasive species including Arundo, Fennel, and Himalayan Blackberry. Qualified herbicide applicators will follow up with herbicide application to prevent erosion. All removed vegetation will be disposed of at an offsite facility.
