Project Description

Project Title: San Bernardino County Flood Control District-
Zone 2 Emergencies February 2025

Project Location: The affected flood control facilities are Cactus Basin 1 and 2, located at the southwestern corner of the intersection of W Baseline Road and N Cactus Avenue in Rialto. Additionally, Cajon Creek Wash is situated between Glen Helen Parkway and the Burlington Northern and Santa Fe Railroad, to the east of Glen Helen Road in the city of San Bernardino.

Project Description: An atmospheric rainstorm resulted in heavy rainfall from February 12-14, 2025, causing significant flooding, along with deposition of sediment, rock, debris, and scour, which damaged flood control facilities. This has created an imminent threat to life and property. Emergency repairs include, but are not limited to, removal of sediment, rock, and debris, as well as the repair or replacement of damaged flood control facilities and appurtenant structures to restore capacity and ensure public safety.


