Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

The proposed project is the repair, re-seal, and re-stripe of the West Public Launch Ramp parking lot as well as the return of the northern perimeter to original grade. The contractor will grade sections of the northern perimeter to return it to the original grade, then repair all cracks in the asphalt, re-seal the entire parking lot with slurry coat, and re-stripe the parking lot.

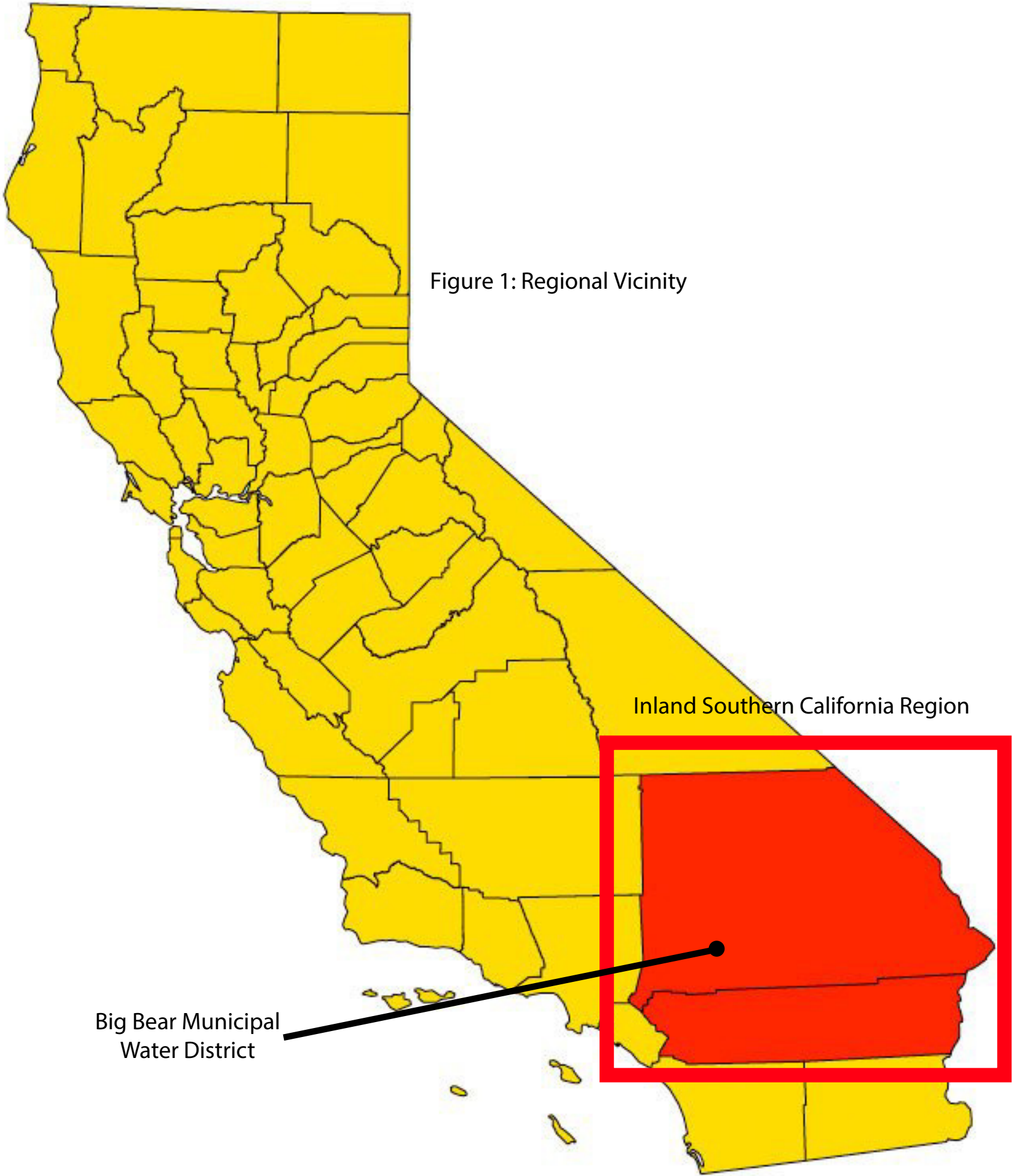
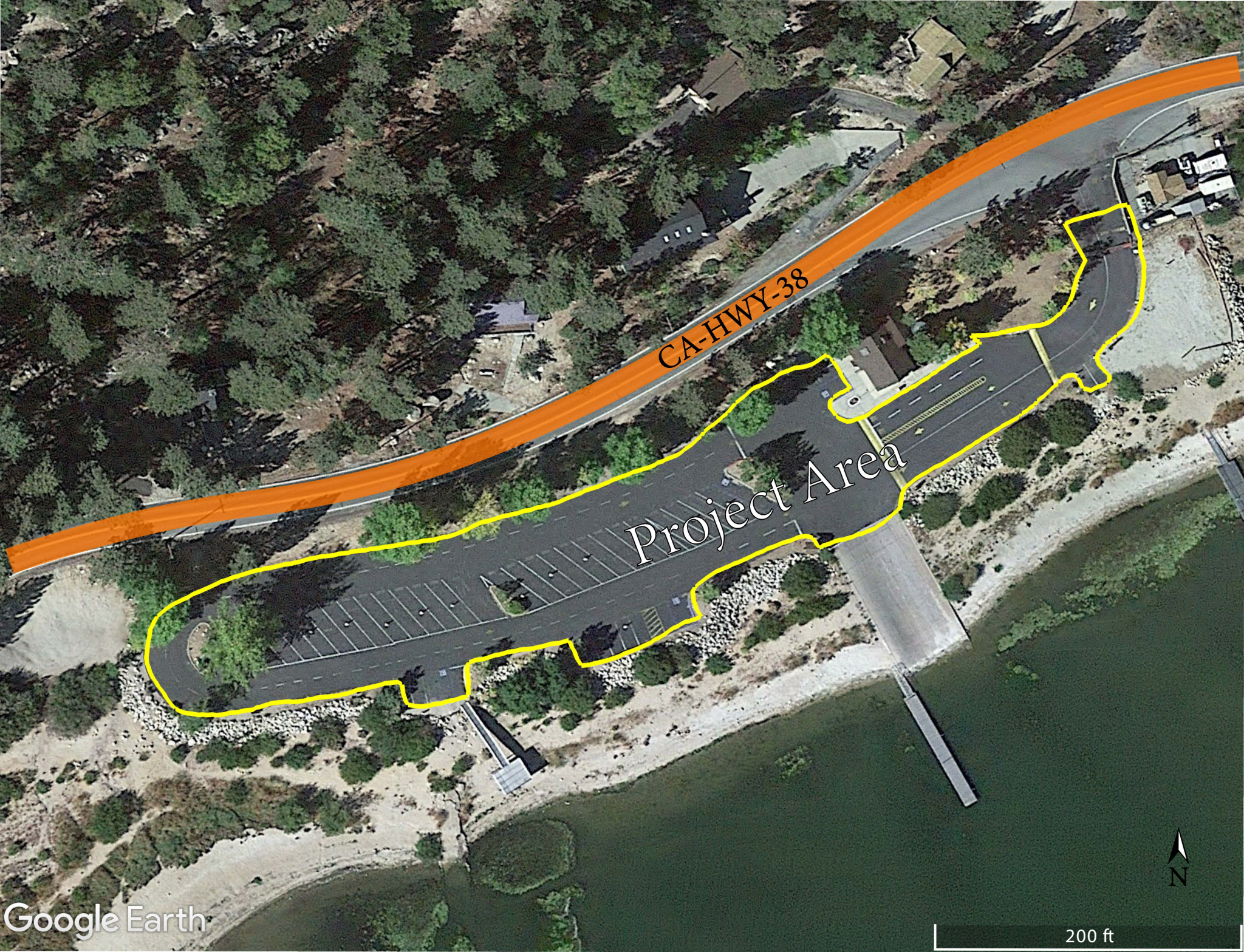


Figure 1: Regional Vicinity
