

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION PURSUANT TO THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

WHO: Project Applicant, Joshua Melcon, **Permit Sonoma File No. MNS21-0002**

WHAT: subdivide a 41.55 -acre parcel resulting in four parcels: lot one at 10.73 acres, lot two at 10.32 acres, lot three at 10.24 acres, and lot four at 10.26 acres in size, the current 41.55 acre parcel is located at 2485 Middle Two Rock Road, **APN 021-160-041. Supervisorial District 2.**

Parcel Zoning: Diverse Agriculture (DA 10), Z (Accessory Dwelling Unit Exclusion), Riparian Corridor (RC50/25) Oak Woodland (OAK)

In accordance with Public Resource Code and CEQA Guidelines, the County of Sonoma provides notice to agencies and interested parties that it is releasing a final Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration IS/MND for the project. The IS/MND did not find potential environmental impacts that could not be mitigated to a less-than-significant level. WHEN: After the close of the IS/MND public review period, the Sonoma County Project Review Advisory Committee is *tentatively* scheduled to hold a public hearing on April 17 2025 to consider the adoption of the IS/MND. A final hearing notice containing instructions on how to attend the meeting will be issued ten (10) days prior to the confirmed hearing date.



The required 30-day public review period on the IS/MND is February 18, 2025 to March 20, 2025. Comments on the IS/MND must be received by **March 20, 2025, at 5:00PM**. All comments received after the review period will be included in the public record for consideration and provided to the decision-making body prior to or at the public hearing scheduled as above.

If you challenge the decision on the project in court you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to Permit Sonoma at or prior to the public hearing.
