Title: Issuance of General Lease – Public Agency Use – Lease 7875

Location: Sovereign land in the Sacramento River, adjacent to Assessor's Parcel Numbers 101-490-011, 112-140-007, and 112-390-007, Redding, Shasta County

Description: Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Public Agency Use to the Applicant, beginning March 1, 2025, for a term of 20 years, for the use and maintenance of one existing vehicle bridge (Lake Redding Bridge) and one existing bicycle/pedestrian bridge (original Diestelhorst Bridge) previously authorized by the Commission and three attached electrical conduits, one water pipeline, a water service pipeline inside a PVC pipeline, light poles and associated electric lines not previously authorized by the Commission.


Exempt Status:

Categorical Exemption:

CLASS 1, EXISTING FACILITIES (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 2, § 2905, subd. (a)(2))

Reasons for exemption:

Issuance of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency for the above-mentioned structures will not cause a physical change in the environment and will not change existing activities in the area. There is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemption applies.
