

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

The project listed below was reviewed for environmental impact by the Placer County Environmental Review Committee and was determined to have no significant effect upon the environment. A proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration and Initial Study & Checklist have been prepared for this project and have been filed with the County Clerk's office.

PROJECT: Dalby Road Over Yankee Slough Bridge

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Placer County Department of Public Works, in cooperation with the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), is proposing to replace the existing Dalby Road Bridge over Yankee Slough with a new single-span bridge structure.

PROJECT LOCATION: It is approximately 500 feet west of the Dalby Road and N. Dowd Road intersection in unincorporated Placer County, California.

PROPONENT: Placer County Department of Public Works
