Statutory Authority: California Health and Safety Code, Chapter 6.5

Project Description: The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) approves of the Class 1* Permit Modification (Permit Modification) to update the soil excavation work plan and extend the closure period for the Safety-Kleen of California, Inc. (S-K) facility located at 44561 Road 30B in Davis, California 95616. S-K is currently undergoing closure work to decontaminate, disassemble, and dispose of equipment and hazardous waste. S-K will continue all other activities directed through the approved Closure Plan. The Permit Modification does not include any other changes in operations, additional construction, or ground disturbing activities.

Background: S-K of Davis is a storage and transfer facility used to collect, and store used oil, oil-water mixtures, and antifreeze. Drums containing used oil, waste antifreeze, solid debris contaminated with oil, and contaminated containers may also be stored at this site. The Davis site consists of four (4) 12,125-gallon steel aboveground storage tanks located within a concrete containment structure. The tanks are supported by steel access platforms and catwalks as well as simple transfer piping. Storage space for eleven (11) 55-gallon drums is located adjacent to the tanks in a concrete containment structure.

S-K acquired this former Evergreen Oil facility in September 2013 and is coordinating the clean closure of the facility with DTSC. Facility operations were conducted in accordance with the April 2008 Series B Standardized Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit, DTSC 2008) and closure activities are being conducted per the Section IX Standard Permit Closure Plan (Closure Plan) within

that Permit. Previous partial closure activities were completed from 2017 through 2020 that focused on the concrete pad loading/unloading area designated as Unit #3 for “truck to truck” transfer. S-K notified DTSC of its intention to close the facility on October 6, 2022. Waste was last received at the facility on November 7, 2022, and full facility closure activities were initiated that same week and have continued to the present.

Project Activities: S-K of Davis is currently undergoing full facility closure including the removal of all waste, removal and disposal of aboveground storage tanks (ASTs), decontamination of a catwalk and concrete structures, removal and disposal of the catwalk, wipe/concrete/soil sampling, and installation of soil gas wells. S-K sampled soil gas, in accordance with the Closure Plan, in October 2023. DTSC provided additional guidance to S-K following review of soil gas results submitted to DTSC in January 2024. S-K of Davis is requesting to excavate approximately 88 cubic yards of petroleum-contaminated soil. S-K is also requesting an extension of the current closure period from October 31, 2024, to June 30, 2025, to complete closure activities. There are no other proposed changes to the closure activities or standards, and the Permit Modification does not include any other changes to closure requirements, operational changes, or new ground disturbing activities at the facility.
