**Project Location:** The project is located northwest of the Coloma Road and Chase Drive intersection in the City of Rancho Cordova in Sacramento County.

**Project Description:** To install approximately 0.35 miles of multi-use path from the Coloma Road/Chase Drive intersection to approximately the Octavia Way/Chase Drive intersection. Project activities include applying roadway pavement and road striping, installing signage and trail lights, relocating existing utilities, and clearing and replanting of existing trees and vegetation with new irrigation lines.

**Reasons Why Project is Exempt:**

The Board has determined that portion of the project from Coloma Road to approximately Octavia Way is exempt from CEQA under the Class 1, Existing Facilities categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15301), because the activity consists of the minor alteration of existing public facilities or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use. No expansion of existing or former use will occur. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15300.2 apply.
