Project Overview The project involves a Zone Change from R1-1-CUGU to (T)(Q)RD1.5-1-CUGU and includes the demolition of 3 existing single-family dwellings units for the construction use and maintenance of a 17 unit apartment with attached garages on an approximate 11,339 square foot lot.
The proposed apartments have varying heights. Building "A" is proposed for a maximum height of 35 feet and 3 inches, while Buildings "B" & "C" are proposed for a maximum height of 36 feet and 9 inches. Building "A" is proposed for a total of 4,822 square feet, while Building "B" is proposed for 11,802 square feet, and Building "C" is proposed for 10,116 square feet of floor area, for a combined total of 26,740 square feet of floor area. The project will provide 33 parking spaces. The project proposes the removal of 8 non-protected trees, and proposes 2,850 square feet of open space including 1,292 square feet of common open space, and 1,600 square feet of private open space. Access to the residences will be from a common driveway with one curb cut on Lorne Street.
