Project Title: Joint Outfall “F” Unit 4 Relief Sewer Rehabilitation

Project Location: The project consists of three (3) segments within the City of Norwalk. The first segment begins at the intersection of Studebaker Road and Alondra Avenue (Manhole Hole (MH) F 0332), then continues northerly on Studebaker Road to approximately 180 feet south of Hayford Street (MH F 0262). The second segment begins on Studebaker Road approximately 130 feet south of Hayford Street (MH F 0263), then continues northerly to Hayford Street, then westerly on Hayford Street to Lefloss Avenue, then northerly on Lefloss Avenue to Liggett Street, then easterly on Liggett Street to approximately 60 feet west of Studebaker Road (MH F 0272). The third segment begins on Studebaker Road approximately 240 feet south of Liggett Street (MH F 0095), then continues northerly on Studebaker Road to Liggett Street (MH F 0096).

Project Description: This project consists of rehabilitation of approximately 5,171 feet of 33- and 39-inch diameter reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) on the Joint Outfall “F” Unit 4 Relief Trunk Sewer, and approximately 304 feet of 33-inch RCP on the Joint Outfall “F” Unit 4 Trunk Sewer with cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) liner. In addition, the project will rehabilitate approximately twelve (12) manholes with a protective coating system, modify one (1) junction structure, and appurtenant work.
