Project Location - Specific: The project is located within the United States Geological Survey (USGS) Palermo quadrangle, primarily within Sections 28 and 29, Township 19N, Range 4E. The project follows the road alignment of Monte Vista Avenue from Lincoln Boulevard to Lower Wyandotte Road and continues on Lower Wyandotte Road north to Las Plumas Avenue in South Oroville, a census designated place, in Butte County, California.

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:

Purpose

The purpose of this project is to improve public safety by installing bike paths along Monte Vista Avenue and Lower Wyandotte Road. This project is needed because this route is utilized by Las Plumas High School students to get to and from school. The new bike paths will close gaps between existing and future improvements adjacent and around Las Plumas High School and enhance pedestrian and bicyclist safety.

Project Description

The project proposes to install Class I and Class II bike paths along the northerly and southerly sides of Monte Vista Avenue from Lincoln Boulevard to Lower Wyandotte Road; and a Class II bike path along the westerly side of Lower Wyandotte Road from Monte Vista Avenue to Las Plumas Avenue. The project also proposes to rehabilitate the existing roadway mainline which includes pulverizing the existing asphalt surface, cement and/or lime treating underlying roadway base materials, and placement of new hot mix asphalt. The new Class I bike path along the northerly side of Monte Vista will be 8-feet wide and also serve pedestrians.
