Reasons why project is exempt: The proposed project is exempt from CEQA based on its conformity with Section 15302 (c) of the CEQA Guidelines. This exemption consists of the replacement of an existing pipeline where the new pipeline will be within the Public Right of Way of Camino Corto, Camino Patricia, Terracina Way and Goetting Way will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the pipeline replaced. The replacement of the existing utility system and/or facilities involve negligible or no expansion of capacity.


