Restore rock slope protection (RSP) at Ardis Ditch Bridges (PM R118.66, Bridge # 54-0201 L/R), Tank Tower Ditch Bridges (PM R119.50, Bridge # 54-0202 L/R), and Homer Wash Bridges (PM R120.47, Bridge # 54-0203 L/R), and to replace Woods Wash Bridges (PM R104.89, Bridge # 54-0802 L/R) on Interstate 40 (I-40) west of the City of Needles in San Bernardino County.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.
