**SUBJECT: NOTICE OF INTENT TO APPROVE THE DRAFT MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION**

**PROJECT: 24<sup>TH</sup> STREET STORAGE PIPE PROJECT (X14170106)**

The City of Sacramento, Community Development Department, Environmental Planning Services has completed preparation of a Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration for the 24<sup>th</sup> Street Storage Pipe Project and intends to adopt the document as part of project review.

The document, and related project plans associated with the project entitlements, are now available for a 30-day public review and comment period. The comment period is from **March 24, 2025, to April 24, 2025.**

You may obtain a copy of the document at 300 Richards Boulevard, Third Floor, Sacramento, CA, 95811 between 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM (except holidays). The proposed project site is located in along 24<sup>th</sup> Street between H Street and N Street, and on K Street, between 24<sup>th</sup> Street and 25<sup>th</sup> Street. The proposed project would install 2,900 linear feet of 120-inch pipe to provide additional underground storage for the combined sewer system. Project improvements will also include an installation of a sewer pump station, asphalt concrete paving, and roadway striping.
