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Project Title: Southern California Edison (SCE) TD2011018 Brockton Ave Deteriorated Pole Replacement Project (Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS- RIV-54845-R6)

Project Location (Riverside County): The project is located on private lands north of the intersection of Eagle Canyon Road and Tin Mine Road along Tin Mine 12kV line in the County of Riverside, California. The geographic location of the project is latitude 33.85894°N, longitude -117.48923°W (Pole 700697H) and latitude 33.84835°N, longitude -117.49202°W (Pole 700686H). The Assessor's Parcel Numbers are 140-060-001-000 and 278-140-012, respectively.

Project Description: The project is limited to the removal and replacement of two deteriorated wood utility poles (Pole 700697H and 700686H) with two new wood utility poles.

Project activities described above are anticipated to temporarily impact 0.058 acres of resources subject to Fish and Game Code Section 1602.
