The purpose of the project is to replace the existing two HDPE culverts that crossed Henson Rd and were damaged in the 2018 Camp Fire with three concrete culverts to meet current stormwater standards, riprap to prevent erosion, and roadway improvements to restore Henson Road to usable condition.

Reasons why project is exempt:

Replacement of the existing damaged culverts is needed because they are currently non functional rendering the roadway impassable and contributing to further erosion of the roadway. The three new culverts will allow the passage of storm water to meet the current Butte County standards, installation of rip rap will protect Henson Road from future erosion, and repairs to Henson Road will render it once again passable. The project would be constructed in approximately the same location as the existing culverts within the Right of Way owned and maintained by PID, and the project area does not present unusual circumstances such that there is a likelihood that the project would result in significant impacts on the environment.
