DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The purpose of this project is to repaint the entry hallway at Leland Stanford Mansion State Historic Park to bring the back the original appearance of the entryway. When the mansion was renovated in 2005, this hallway was considered a service entry, and the historic fabric was covered-up with paint. Project will:

- Remove the layers of paint covering the trim, doors, window, wainscot and dumbwaiter;
- Replace inappropriate or missing baseboards with like/kind in type and appearance; and
- Clean and skim coat walls to create finish fitting with other rooms in the mansion.

Work will not destroy or replace any historic fabric in the mansion. All work will be done in accordance with the Secretary of Interior Standards for Rehabilitation of Historic Structures.
