Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Metro is proposing the Los Angeles Union Station Closed-Circuit Television System Upgrades Project. The Project would replace the existing non-functional and/or end-of-life cameras and infrastructure within two rail yard areas located at Los Angeles Union Station. The Project will replace all cameras, conduit, battery backup systems and connect these cameras to the existing Genetec VMS with new licenses. Cameras are physically located on the passenger platforms within the main rail yard area, located east of the historic Union Station building and primarily utilized by Metrolink and Amtrak agencies, as well as cameras located within the exclusive Amtrak Garden Tracks yard, northwest of the main rail yard.
