Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The proposed project would be implemented on a District-owned property on approximately 8 acres of the 49.45-acre C campus in the Costa Mesa High School of Costa Mesa. The proposed project would include construction of a new building, expanding two existing buildings, installing new permanent home and away bleachers, track improvements, various improvements to the existing tennis courts on campus, a new fire lane, and landscaping. The proposed project would not include changes to existing walkways or lighting.

The proposed project would allow for more seating for spectators for sports games and other school events; enhance the usability of the tennis courts for athletes and spectators; add new athletic and school facilities for the staff and students; and enhance safety by constructing a fire access lane.

The environmental assessment presented in the IS/MND identifies environmental impacts that would be potentially significant unless mitigation measures are incorporated into the project for: Cultural Resources, Geology and Soils, and Tribal Cultural Resources. The IS/MND analysis determined that all impacts from the proposed project would be less than significant after mitigation. The Initial Study supports the adoption of a Mitigated Negative Declaration.
