


Project Location:	North of State Route 210 and west of Del Rosa Avenue in the City of San Bernardino		
Project Description:	<p>SBCTA will issue a temporary rights of use permit to CT&T Concrete Paving Inc. (contractor) who plans to utilize the site as storage for excavated soil and equipment as part of the State Route 210 at Waterman Avenue Interchange Project.</p> <p>Contractor will employ best management practices (BMPs) for stormwater, erosion, and dust during use of site and will restore the site to pre-use conditions after use. Use will not result in permanent physical changes.</p> <p>Contractor will be required to comply with local ordinances and requirements. Use of the site under this rights of use permit will not exceed 12 months.</p>		
Project Background:	CT&T Concrete Paving Inc. is SBCTA's contractor for the construction of improvements at State Route 210 and Waterman Avenue Interchange. The site is proposed to be used to temporarily store excavated soil and construction equipment such as trucks.
