Project Location: The project is located at 2320 Kayla Ct, in the City of Marysville, within Area C of the Yuba River Designated Floodway, in Yuba County.

Project Description: To construct a 2,951 square foot single-family residence with attached garage and covered porch in an existing subdivision located within the Yuba River Designated Floodway. Site improvements include a storage building, pump house, propane tank, well, solar array, and a septic system to service the residence.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The Board has determined the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 3, New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15303), because the activity consists of construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures; installation of small new equipment and facilities in small structures; and the conversion of existing small structures from one use to another where only minor modifications are made in the exterior of the structure. Additionally, the project is exempt from CEQA under the Class 4, Minor Alterations to Land categorical exemption (CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15304), because the activity consists of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, water, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees except for forestry or agricultural purposes. Further, none of the exceptions to the exemption in CEQA California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Section 15300.2 apply.
