Title: Issuance of General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use– Lease 9187

Location: Sovereign land in Steamboat Slough, adjacent to 3446 Snug Harbor Drive, on Ryer Island, near Walnut Grove, Solano County

Description: Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use beginning February 20, 2025, for a term of 10 years, for the use of an existing boat dock, ramp, and bank protection.

There is no reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances. Therefore, the project will not have a significant effect on the environment and the above categorical exemption applies.
