Project Title: San Bernardino Storm Drain Routine Maintenance (Notification of Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-SBR-49747-R6)

Project Location (San Bernardino County): The San Bernardino Storm Drain Routine Maintenance (Project) is located within a tributary to San Timoteo Wash, in the City of Loma Linda, County of San Bernardino, State of California; Latitude 34.057876, Longitude -117.26538. The Project is located within a storm drain that ties into Loma Linda Storm Drain, beginning at the Southern Pacific Railroad tracks approximately 300 feet west of Anderson Street.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SBR-49747-R6, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to San Bernardino County Flood Control District.

The Project is limited to the routine maintenance for the San Bernardino Storm Drain that involves: obstruction removal (such as debris and trash removal and encampment management), minor as-needed repairs, access road maintenance and fence/gate repair, and vegetation management.
