Title: Issuance of General Lease – Other – Lease 9129

Location: Sovereign land in the Lower Waukell Creek, tributary to the Klamath River estuary, adjacent to Assessor’s Parcel Numbers 140-130-13 and 140-130-028, near Crescent City, Del Norte County

Description: Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Other beginning April 2, 2025, for a term of 20 years, for the monitoring of an existing fish spawning habitat restoration site consisting of 10 constructed wood jams, monitoring antennas, and seasonal migration traps.
