Present Land Use/Zoning/General Plan Designation:

All beach sites are zoned as Open Space and are currently beaches used for recreation and enjoyment.

Project Description: *(please use a separate page if necessary)*: The proposed project would include beach nourishment of five receiver sites where high-quality sediment material would be placed at the existing beaches to protect against erosion. The Los Angeles County Department of Beach and Harbors (LACDBH) Sand Compatibility Opportunistic Use Program (SCOUP) includes five receiver sites: Zuma Beach, Will Rogers State Beach, Dockweiler State Beach, Manhattan Beach, and Redondo Beach that were selected by LACDBH based on a variety of criteria that include present and future coastal erosion and flooding vulnerabilities, presence of existing resources, presence of critical public infrastructure and amenities, recreational and economic benefits, and avoidance of adverse effects on coastal resources. Trucks would be used to transport sediment material to each beach site, where it would be stockpiled, and then placed along the beach site using heavy equipment.
