DESCRIPTION OF ACTIVITY/PROJECT: The project includes the repair and replacement in kind as necessary, the existing Old Sacramento waterfront dock improvements, including: recladding the existing wood docks with aluminum decking, replacement of the protective electrical equipment enclosure adjacent to the River City Queen boat moorings, replacement of protective hand railing along the docks, replacement of dock lighting and floatation, painting of bridges and stairwells that extend from the seawall to waterfront area and repair of the existing trash diverter.

REASONS WHY ACTIVITY/PROJECT IS EXEMPT: The proposed action would repair, remove and/or replace infrastructure in disrepair and past its useful life that facilitates public and staff access to existing Old Sacramento Waterfront amenities. The action responds to facility maintenance and pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15302 (Replacement or Reconstruction) are exempt from CEQA review. **15301-** the actions consist of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, and minor alteration of existing public structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features involving negligible or no expansion of use. **15302 –** the actions also consist of the replacement or reconstruction of existing structures and facilities where the new structure will be located on the same site as the structure replaced and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the structure replaced.
