PURPOSE AND BENEFICIARIES OF
PROJECT:

The City of Lakeport proposes the 10th Street / North Street Sidewalk Repair Project, which involves the removal and replacement of damaged sidewalk, curb, and gutter sections along 10th Street and North Street. The project includes:

- Demolition and removal of deteriorated concrete sidewalk, curb, and gutter.
- Installation of new pedestrian infrastructure, including ADA-compliant curb ramps to improve accessibility.
- Restoration of adjacent pavement surfaces to integrate new sidewalk sections.
- Protection or relocation of existing utilities as necessary to accommodate sidewalk improvements.

This project is intended to enhance pedestrian safety, improve accessibility, and maintain public infrastructure in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and local municipal standards. The work will be conducted within the existing public right-of-way and will not result in significant environmental impacts.
