Project Title: Sutter Creek Clearing Routine Maintenance (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. AMA-47731-R2)

Project Location: The project is located within the City boundaries, covering 1.9 miles of natural creek and channels. The project occurs within USGS quadrangles, Latitude 38.396823 to 38.392840 and Longitude -120.827310 to -120.796078.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number AMA-47731-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Sutter Creek as represented by Daniel Lafontaine.

The project is limited to multiple routine maintenance projects that the City of Sutter Creek will complete at different time periods during the project term and a description of a procedure the entity must follow for any covered maintenance projects. Authorized maintenance activities include debris or obstruction removal, vegetation control in channels or on banks, invasive species removal, and small habitat restorations.
