Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The applicant is requesting approval of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to permit a stealth telecommunications facility. The proposed project consists of installation of a new 90-foot (ft.) broadleaf tree pole with twelve (12) 8 ft. antennas, a microwave dish, three (3) ground mounted cabinets, and associated small equipment. All facility equipment will be on raised concrete pad and contained within a 16 ft. by 31 ft. fenced lease area, located approximately 55 ft. from the nearest property boundary. Plans indicate potential future co-location. A 30Kw backup generator has been proposed.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Mitigation Measure for Biological resources are preconstruction surveys to establish if suitable habitat exists for endangered and threatened species. One for the American Badger, one for special status plant species, and one for nesting bird survey. There is one mitigation measure for cultural resources which covers the discovery of human remains requiring an archaeologist to determine if they're culturally significant. The final two mitigation measures are Tribal Cultural resource mitigation measure. One requires all personnel to undergo tribal cultural awareness training to recognize discovering tribal cultural resources. The final mitigation measure addresses discovery of tribal cultural resource.
