Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: Oak Grove Bible Fellowship has requested to amend and supersede Use Permit 91-82 to allow a 5,591-square-foot of addition to the existing church facilities consisting of a new fellowship hall, an extension of the existing sanctuary and kitchen area, classrooms to facilitate church related activities, restrooms, storage, and a rear porch area. Additional improvements include a 18,500-square-foot parking area, new driveway encroachment on Old 44 Drive, new curb, gutter and sidewalk, landscaping, a proposed playground area, septic tank and pump, and other ancillary site improvements.
