Project Title: Retaining Wall at 3220 Mulberry Drive Retaining Wall Project (Notification of Lake or Streambed Alteration, No. EPIMS-SCR-49908-R3)

Project Location (Santa Cruz): The Project is located at 3220 Mulberry Drive, City of Soquel, in the County of Santa Cruz, State of California; Latitude 36.98997, Longitude -121.93659; Assessor's Parcel Number 037-311-43.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SCR-49908-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Diane Brembor.

In 2023, heavy storms caused a landslide on the banks of an unnamed creek tributary to Soquel Creek, immediately behind a single-family home. The purpose of the Project is to stabilize the bank adjacent to the creek to protect the property from further erosion. The Project is limited to the installation of a 60-foot (ft) long and 6-ft tall pin pier retaining wall in the eroded area.
