Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project: Installation of a new railroad crossing system at an existing intersection that currently has no warning systems. Proposal includes repaving, aprons at driveways, and widening to 24' w/ 3' shoulders of the roadway and adjusting the slope of the approaches by adding fill for 500' on both sides of the track. The project is needed to improve safety of the crossing on Keys Rd in Sutter County.
