**Project Title:** Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS- SIS-59129-R1 for 2-25EM-00042-SIS.

**Project Location:** The project is located on Clark Creek, in the County of Siskiyou, State of California; in the Clark Creek Watershed (1105.420408) Township 41N, Range 09W, Section 9; Mount Diablo Base and Meridian; USGS 7.5 minute quadrangle "Etna, CA".

**Project Description:** As part of Emergency 2-25EM-00042- SIS, the project is limited to one temporary encroachment of a rock armored culvert on a Class I channel utilizing one-three 18" CMP culverts. Culverts shall be placed at grade, and native rock will be used to back-fill culvert. Culverts must be removed upon completion of use, rock fill shall be dipped through the channel and spread on site. Crossing is identified as "Crossing X1" and work is described through email notification correspondence and information submitted associated with EPIMS #SIS-59129-R1.
