PROJECT TITLE: Redwood Rising Wayside Sign Installation

LOCATION: Del Norte Coast Redwoods State Park **COUNTY:** Del Norte

DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT: The purpose of this project is to install informational signs at Del Norte Coast Redwoods State Park to inform the public about restoration activities undertaken by Redwood Rising. The signs will inform visitors about the current watershed, road, and watershed restoration activities to provide greater understanding about the restoration work, its needs, processes and goals. There will be additional signs located on nearby National Park Service land as part of this effort. Work will:

- Hand excavate two (2) to three (3), 1-ft diameter by 2-ft deep holes;
- Place one (1) post in each hole and backfill with cement to secure each post;
- Cover the concrete with excavated soils; and
- Attach vertical panels with information regarding Redwood Rising and the restoration work to the posts in a manner that meets all ADA requirements.

REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT: Project consists of the operation, maintenance, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of use beyond current levels; construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures, listed as “Construction or installation of park facilities, such as interpretive signing or panels” in the Department of Parks and Recreation’s list of exempt activities in accordance with CCR §15300.4; and consists of minor public or private alterations in the condition of land, and/or vegetation which do not involve removal of healthy, mature, scenic trees.
