**Project Title:** Dominguez Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-TRI-57264-R1C)

**Project Location (include county):** The Project to be completed is located within the Mad River watershed, within the town of Mad River, County of Trinity, State of California. The Project is located at 261 Dogwood Lane, Mad River, CA 95552; in Section 21, T1N, R6E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Sportshaven U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 018-670-002-000; latitude 40.4486N and longitude 123.4968 W.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-TRI-57264-R1C, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Epimenio Dominguez.

The Project is limited to three encroachments. Three encroachments are to upgrade existing culverts. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the existing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

**Reasons why project is exempt:** The project will authorize the replacement of three existing culverts to improve the passage of water and debris and minimize erosion. There would be no significant adverse impact on endangered, rare or threatened species or their habitat pursuant to section 15065. There are no hazardous materials at or around the project site that may be disturbed or removed. The project will not result in impacts that are significant when viewed in connection with the effects of past projects, the effects of other current projects, and the effects of probable future projects.
