Project Title: 10 Mile Gardens (Project)

Project Location: The Project is located at 013-790-20-01, in Mendocino County.

County: Mendocino County

Project Description: The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Profession Code, Section 26012, approved a Small Outdoor commercial cannabis license submitted on November 27, 2023, by 10 Mile Gardens.

Project Activities: The Project will consist of a small outdoor cultivation license for commercial cannabis. The project site is located at 1560 Ten Mile Creek Road in Laytonville Mendocino County CA 95454 (APN 013-790-20-01). The proposed project is for 10,000 sf of mature cultivation and 3,000 immature canopy within a 20,000-acre project footprint. The current cannabis cultivation footprint was established circa 2019. Irrigation is supplied by an existing on-site ground water well and is anticipated to require 247,500 gallons a year. Power is supplied by PG&E through existing infrastructure with a yearly projection total of 4320 kWh.
