NOTICE OF EXEMPTION

Project Title:

Happy Bees Cargo Containers

Project Location:

The project site is located on the east side of 16th Street, approximately 940 feet south of the intersection of 16th Street and U Street, in the Rio Linda/Elverta community of unincorporated Sacramento County.

Description of Project:

The project includes a request for a Minor Use Permit to legalize the placement of four (4) cargo containers used for the storage of bee hives and associated effects. Container One (1) consists of 320 square feet and is located due west of the single-family residence. Container Two (2) consists of 320 square feet and is located due north of Container One. Container Three (3) consists of 160 square feet and is located perpendicular to Container Two. Container Four (4) consists of 320 square feet and is located near the eastern property line.

Exempt Status:

Categorical Exemption (PRC Section 21084; CEQA Guidelines Sections 15300-15333):

- CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 – Existing Facilities

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

Class One (1) consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. The key consideration is whether the project involves negligible or no expansion of use. The project consists of the continued use of four (4) existing cargo containers for bee hives and associated effects, which were placed on site without attaining the appropriate permit(s). As the project involves the permitting of existing structures with no negligible or expansion of use,

the project would be eligible for the CEQA exemption pursuant to Section 15301 and is therefore exempt from the provisions of CEQA.

Section 15300.2-Exceptions

Section 15300.2 of the CEQA Guidelines, Exceptions, provides conditions under which categorical exemptions are inapplicable. Review of the Project indicates that it will not violate any of the exceptions, as described in the following section.

1. *For Classes 3, 4, 5, 6, and 11, will the project have an impact on an environmental resource of hazardous or critical concern where designated, precisely mapped, and officially adopted pursuant to law by federal, state, or local agencies?*

The Project Exemption is not one of the above Classes and this exception does not apply.

2. *Will cumulative impacts be considerable because successive projects of the same type will occur at the same place over time?*

As it stands, the project will not result in potentially significant impacts. Therefore, no cumulative impacts will result from the Project and successive projects of the same type and at the same place over time.

3. *Is there a reasonable possibility that the activity will have a significant effect on the environment due to unusual circumstances?*

There are no known unusual circumstances that will have a significant effect on the environment.

4. *Will the project result in damage to scenic resources, including but not limited to trees, historic buildings, rock outcroppings, or similar resources within a highway officially designated as a scenic highway?*

River Road/ Highway 160 (from the Sacramento City Limits at the northern edge of Freeport to the southern tip of the Delta at Antioch Bridge) is a designated State Scenic Highway. The Project is not located within the vicinity of this scenic highway. Therefore, the project will not result in damage to scenic resources or similar resources within a highway that is officially designated as a scenic highway.

5. *Is the project located on a site which is included on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code?*

The Project site is not included on any list compiled pursuant to Section 65962.5 of the Government Code. Therefore, the Project will not have an impact related to being located on a hazardous waste site.

6. *Will the project cause a substantial adverse change in the significance of a historic resource?*

The project site does not contain any historical resource.
