Project Title: Grant Line Road Widening (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0318-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Elk Grove Creek and associated tributaries along Grant Line Road in the City of Elk Grove, in the County of Sacramento, State of California; Latitude 38.395184, Longitude -121.339412 within Section 5, Township 6N, Range 6E, in U.S. Geological Survey map Elk Grove, Assessor's Parcel Number 13-0110-153, 134-0120-014, 134-0190-002, and 134-0190-009 approximately from the Waterman Road/Grant Line Road intersection to the Grant Line Road/Bradshaw Road intersection.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0318-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the City of Elk Grove, as represented by John Griffin.

The proposed project will expand the existing Grant Line Road to a four-lane expressway with a Class 1 bike/pedestrian trail from Waterman Road to Bradshaw Road. The project will also include utility relocation, drainage facilities improvements to support the new roadway, and the realignment of the Grant Line Road/Bradshaw Road intersection. The project includes the following components: grading and a culvert replacement

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 8/12/2020 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
