

Dear Applicant:

The Department of Fish and Game (Department) received your notification package and application fee. The Department determined that your notification package was complete on December 5, 2002, and has assigned your proposed project or activity to the appropriate field person. You should be contacted within 30 days of the date the Department received your completed notification package. During that period, the Department will determine whether your proposed project or activity may have an impact on fish or wildlife resources.

If the Department determines that your proposed project or activity may substantially adversely affect an existing fish or wildlife resource, you will need to obtain a Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement that includes measures necessary to protect fish or wildlife before you may begin your project or activity. As explained in the "Questions and Answers" document that was sent with your notification package, the Department may not issue a Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement until your proposed project or activity has been reviewed in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Pub. Resources Code, §§21000-21177), unless it is exempt from CEQA review.

Unless an agency other than the Department has already complied with CEQA for the project or activity described in your completed notification package, the Department will act as the lead agency for your project or activity. If a lead agency has already complied with CEQA for your project or activity, please provide the Department with a copy of all applicable CEQA documents or the address where these documents may be obtained, unless you have already submitted these documents to the Department.

If the Department determines that your proposed project or activity will not substantially adversely affect an existing fish or wildlife resource, you will not need a Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement and you will be able to proceed with your project or activity, unless you need to obtain other permits.

Please note that you may not proceed with your project or activity until the Department determines whether you need a Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement and, if so, after your proposed project or activity has been reviewed under CEQA, if necessary. The Department will make every effort to process your notification as quickly as possible.
