PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Carnegie SVRA and Mitchell Ravine Projects IS/MND was adopted by the Department of Parks and Recreation in 2010. The IS/MND included implementing continued long-term storm water facilities maintenance including the maintenance of storm water detention basins and culvert clean-out at the District Office Road where it crosses Corral Hollow Creek. This addendum will include additional culverts in the vicinity of the Maintenance Bridge. The additional activity identified does not meet the conditions described in Section 15162 of the State CEQA Guidelines.

This is to advise that the California Department of Parks and Recreation has approved the above project on August 15, 2023, and has made the following determinations regarding the above described project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. An Addendum to the Negative Declaration was prepared for this project, pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
