Project Location/City/County: The project is located along River Road approximately 5.65 miles southwest of Chico, near RM 193.9, in Butte County.

Project Description: Approval of Permit No. 19320, under California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To remove two existing berms, non-native vegetation, and walnut orchard; to authorize an existing agricultural well with related utility poles; planting of riparian vegetation and native grasses with irrigation; creation of a flow-through meadow, trails, and vehicle barriers along the Sacramento River and Mud Creek. The project is a component of the Bidwell-Sacramento River State Park Habitat Restoration and Outdoor Recreation Facilities Development Project that includes the 43-acre parcel referred to as the Singh Unit.
