Project Title: Modifications at the Robert A. Nelson Transfer Station/Material Recovery Facility (RAN TS/MRF) to include a 7,630 square foot pre-engineered metal building with a THOR bio-separator to process food waste

Project Location: The Project site is located at 1830 Agua Mansa Road in the City of Jurupa Valley. It is also described as a portion of Riverside County Assessor Parcel Numbers (APNs) 175-180-018 and 175-190-029.

Project Description: The Project involves minor modifications to the facility site and facility permits at RAN TS/MRF to include a 7,630 square foot pre-engineered metal building at the RAN TS/MRF including, but not limited to, footings and foundations, structural design, mechanical, electrical, and plumbing components of the metal building, to house a THOR bio-separator to process food waste. The THOR bio-separator is a mechanized system that automatically removes contaminants, such as plastic or paper, for bagged food waste. The remaining organic material is blended to create a "cake" product and is then moved to the existing Engineered Compost Systems (ECS) Biofilter Aerated Static Pile (ASP) Composting System and blended with ground green waste to produce a compost feedstock.

This is to advise that the Riverside County Board of Supervisors has approved the above-referenced project on March 11, 2025 and has made the following determinations regarding that project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration (adopted by the Board of Supervisors on 6/04/19), an Addendum (Addendum No. 1, adopted by the Board of Supervisors on 02/09/21), and an Addendum (Addendum No. 2, adopted by the Board of Supervisors on 03/11/25) were prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were previously made a condition of the approval for the project analyzed under EA 2015-03.
4. A mitigation monitoring program was previously adopted for the project analyzed under EA 2015-03.
5. A statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.
6. Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
