Project Title: Wilson Creek Bridge Construction (Streambed Alteration Agreement 1600-2018-0242-R2)

Project Location: The project is located on Wilson Creek at County Road 35 in the County of Glenn, State of California, Latitude: 39.61151° North, Longitude: 122.24451° West.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has extended Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement 1600-2018-0242-R2, pursuant to section 1605 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Glenn County Public Works Agency.

This extension modifies the Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement term from November 8, 2023, to November 8, 2028. The project consists of removal of a failing low water crossing and construction of an elevated vehicle bridge crossing of the creek including construction of all necessary bridge support abutments and implementation of all necessary Best Management Practices (BMPs).

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, has extended the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were / were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
