**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0212-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Matt Graul, East Bay Regional Park District.

The project is limited to sediment removal and embankment/spillway repair on existing livestock ponds.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as  the Lead Agency /  a Responsible Agency approved the above described project on August 26, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
