Project Title: Amendment #1 to PLC North On and Off Site Commercial Development and Road Improvement Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-RIV-26376-R6)

Project Location (include county): The Amendment to the Project is located at the historic Case Road Bridge crossing of San Jacinto River, within the City of Perris, County of Riverside, State of California..

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed and issued an amendment to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-RIV-26376-R6 pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant IDI Logistics, as represented by Brian Caris.

The amendment to the Project includes a minor design change, and increase in temporary and permanent impacts, related to the reconstruction of historic Case Road Bridge.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described amendment on January 22, 2025, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
