Project Title: Recology Hay Road Landfill Expansion (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0065-R3)

Project Location: The project is located approximately eight miles southeast of the City of Vacaville at 6426 Hay Road in unincorporated Solano County. The project site is bounded by Hay Road to the north, State Route 113 to the east, Burke Lane to the west, and Burke Ranch Conservation Bank to the south.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0065-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Recology Hay Road, as represented by Salvatore M. Coniglio.

The project includes realigning an unnamed drainage ditch by filling approximately 2,760 linear feet of unnamed drainage ditch and 0.04 acres of a detention basin, and creating a new approximately 1,325-linear foot drainage ditch.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on _____ and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
