Title: American River Watershed Common Features, Water Resources Development Act of 2016 Project, American River Contract 1

Proponent: Central Valley Flood Protection Board

Location: Approximately 8.85 acres of sovereign land located in the American River in subreach 2 and 3.85 acres of sovereign land in the American River adjacent to Glenn Hall Park, city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

Description: Construction, use, and maintenance of existing levee erosion control repair sites not previously authorized by the Commission; and construction, use, and maintenance of planting benches and riprap bank protection. Mitigation activities related to the American River Common Features (ARCF) Site 2-1 erosion control Project. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through June 28, 2041.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as  Lead Agency  Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on June 29, 2021, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project  will  will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An  Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures  were  were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was or  was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations  was  was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings  were  were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, CVFPB, certified the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and Mitigation Monitoring Program (MMP) and approved the project on June 9, 2016. The CVFPB then prepared a Supplemental EIR (American River Watershed Common Features, Water Resources Development Act of 2016 Project, American River Contract 1), and certified the Supplemental EIR (SEIR) on May 28, 2021, and adopted a MMP. The California State Lands Commission has considered the EIR and SEIR as prepared for this project by CVFPB and adopted an independent MMP incorporating CVFPB's document. The EIR, SEIR, and the record of project approval may be examined at the above shown California State Lands Commission Sacramento office address.
