Title: American River Watershed Common Features, Water Resources Development Act of 2016 Project, Sacramento Weir Widening Project

Proponent: Central Valley Flood Protection Board

Location: Approximately 9.68 acres of sovereign land located along the west bank of the Sacramento River, adjacent to 22568 Old River Road, West Sacramento, Yolo County.

Description: The Project includes constructing a 1,500-foot-long passive weir, with associated levee, roadway, rail, and fish passage improvements. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through December 7, 2041.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as  Lead Agency  Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on December 8, 2021, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project  will  will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An  Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures  were  were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was or  was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations  was  was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings  were  were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, the Central Valley Flood Protection Board (CVFPB), certified an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) on June 9, 2016. In addition, the CVFPB certified a project specific Supplemental EIR and MMRP, and certified the Supplemental EIR on August 27, 2021. The California State Lands Commission has considered the EIR and Supplemental EIR as prepared for this project by Central Valley Flood Protection Board and adopted an independent MMP incorporating CVFPB's document. The EIR, Supplemental EIR, and the record of project approval may be examined at the above shown California State Lands Commission Sacramento office address.
