Title: American River Watershed Common Features, Water Resources Development Act of 2016 Project, Sacramento River East Levee Contract 4

Applicant: Central Valley Flood Protection Board

Location: 12,844 cumulative feet of Sovereign land in the Sacramento River, adjacent to the east bank of the Sacramento at several sites in the city of Sacramento, Sacramento County.

Description: The Sacramento River East Levee (SREL) Contract 4 project includes the installation of levee improvements to meet embankment and foundation stability requirements along various sections of the SREL in Sacramento, California. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 20-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through February 27, 2043.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on February 28, 2023, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, Central Valley Flood Protection Board (CVFPB) certified the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program and approved the project on October 28, 2022. The California State Lands Commission has considered the EIR as prepared for this project by the CVFPB and adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program incorporating the CVFPB's document. The EIR and the record of project approval may be examined at the above shown California State Lands Commission Sacramento office address.
