**Project Title:** Trancas Creek Bridge Replacement Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0117-R5)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at Trancas Creek on Pacific Coast Highway between post mile 56.5 and 57.5. The project is within the City of Malibu in Los Angeles County of Los Angeles, California.


**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed an amendment to Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0117-R5, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

The project is limited to replacing the existing 97-foot-long bridge with a 240-foot long bridge, restoring an estuary, constructing a wider bike path, integrating a pedestrian pathway, relocating a water line, and restoring all areas of disturbance. The project requested an extension of the seasonal work window to December 30 for the 2023 season.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on \_\_\_/\_\_\_/\_\_\_ and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
